Summary of Centre Director's Report

At the end of January 2010, the PYFC trustees and staff arranged a Trustee Day and invited Liz Etherton from National Youth for Christ to lead the day. Liz reminded us there are the 4 key areas of ministry that as a YFC centre we covenant to provide and deliver for this area of the country. These are

Demonstration: The practice of demonstrating acceptance and love by engaging in community development as a means of alleviating material need and/or building long-term, unconditional relationships with young people.

Declaration: Any means of communicating the Gospel that invites people to make an informed choice about what has been communicated.

Decision: As a part of the faith journey, decision is the point at which a person becomes aware of the need to make this informed choice to follow Christ and does so.

Discipleship: A process by which people follow Jesus and grow in their relationship with Him.

In a time of reflection of PYFC work, we realised that the majority of our work is demonstration and declaration but little is decision and discipleship. This led us to develop 3 strategic aims for the next 3 years.

- Increased emphasis on Decision and Discipleship
- Strengthening internal infrastructure
- Increased local presence

We will be exploring and planning how to work towards the strategic aims in the Trustee Body meetings in the coming months.
